The Weslaco Independent School District is pleased to announce that it will continue its policy to operate the Community Eligibility Program (CEP) under the National School Lunch Program and the School Breakfast Program for the 2017-2018 school year. All children enrolled at the Weslaco ISD will continue to receive a meal at no charge unless otherwise notified. Be assured that your child/children will receive a free nutritious lunch and breakfast regardless of your income or family size.
